AFTER ATTENDING the university, I worked as a research and development engineer at the Max-Planck-Institute, following 20 years as Quality chief-manager in the automotive industry.

Entered the PSK (Pinscher - Schnauzer Klub, Germany) in 1978 and the “story of dogs” began. 15 years later, I took his first steps into breeding under the kennel name “vom Mausegatt” - Standard Schnauzer and German Pinscher. Following this, I have bred Giant Schnauzer and trained them as well. Currently I am still breeding, continuing with German Pinscher and miniature pinscher, under the kennel name of “DelFharo”.

Within PSK am I a breed expert judge for all pinscher and schnauzer breeds, FCI standard Nr. 181-186. In the PSK I also instructs the junior judges and conducts their examinations.

On a number of occasions, have I been invited to judge in several European countries as well as in the USA. Amongst others have I judged Giant Schnauzer at Bundes-Sieger-Zuchtschau, Europa-Sieger-Zuchtschau and FCI World Dog Show.

I have also been the President of the PSK (Pinscher-Schnauzer Klub, Germany) and the President of ISPU (International Schnauzer Pinscher Union).
